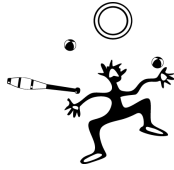

From JH, Wendy will drive the Assistants to & from the libraries and stay on site. The Noon arrival time to prepare & travel is off-set by the fact that library gig leaders may leave upon returning to JH around 3:30.)

INCENTIVES

Student leaders must treat their role like a job. With experience*, Assistants can earn tuition credit equal to the camp for which they work (i.e., most Assistants simply juggle in the other half of the day or accrue punches for other days). You may instead apply your time to the 10 hours of community service standard for Ultimate Club or general community service. **How would you like to be rewarded as a summer leader (asst. or volunteer)?**
