Founded and directed in 1994 by Paul Arneberg, JUGHEADS Youth Juggling Company is an after-school, evening, and summer juggling program based in Edina, MN. Currently, more than 130 kids in seven distinct weekly JUGHEADS clubs meet to hone juggling skills, learn new tricks, and work on routines. These youth jugglers' skills have progressed well beyond the basics: many Jugheads have mastered seven balls, six rings, five clubs, 6 – 10 club passing, the diabalo, the unicycle, devil sticks, and the two-foot diameter walking globe. The motto of JUGHEADS is “Developing Youth Through Juggling Since 1994,” and the virtues of good character, friendship, and mentorship under gird every aspect of the company.

JUGHEADS' accomplishments include 12-time Minnesota State Fair Amateur Talent Contest Semi-Finalists from 1999-2011 (including several runners-up and three acts that advanced to the Grandstand finals, and one act winning the teen division in 2011); numerous appearances on local and national television and printed media; the International Juggler's Association's (IJA) Founder's Award for “capturing the spirit of Vaudeville” in 1999; the 2000 IJA Excellence in Education Award; IJA juggling and juggling competition winners; two IJA Bronze and Silver Medalists in the Juniors (solo) Championships; four-time IJA Bronze Medalists, one-time Silver Medalists, and 2010 Gold Medalists in the IJA Teams Championships.

Paul Arneberg has worked full-time with youth for 18 years. He and his team of coaches use their passion for mentorship, performance, communication and good virtues to positively influence the lives of youth in the community. With full-time support from Paul's wife, Wendy, JUGHEADS now spans 10 grades (3–12), produces two annual productions, offers a high school lettering program, and travels yearly to various festivals and events with the top-level performers.
